Minority Owned Business:	A Minority-Owned Business (MBE) is a small business concern that is at least 51% owned by one or more minorities (Black, Asian, Hispanic, Native American, Hawaiian, or Pacific Asian). A publicly owned business; at least 51% of the stock is owned by one or more minorities who control the management and daily business operations. Small Disadvantaged Business:	Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB) must be a small business that is socially and economically disadvantaged as defined by the SBA at https://www.sba.gov/federal-contracting/contracting-assistance-programs/8a-business-development-program .
Woman Owned Business:	Woman-Owned Business (WOSB) is a small business that is at least 51% owned by one or more women. A publicly owned business; at least 51% of the stock is owned by one or more women who control the management and daily business operations. Veteran-Owned Business:	Veteran-Owned Business (VOSB) is a small business that is at least 51% owned by one or more veterans. Service-Disabled Veteran Business:	Service-Disabled Veteran Business (SDVOSB) is a small business that is at least 51 % owned or controlled by one or more American Veteran(s) with service-connected physical or mental impairments.
